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INTRODUCTION AND MAIN AIMS

Researchers from ciTechCare and School of Health Sciences (occupational Therapy and other disciplines) of Polytechnic of Leiria promotes the Gulbenkian Academies of Knowledge project, with the aim of developing social and emotional skills that prepare children and young people for your future, from 3 to 8 years old. We will invest and qualifying the future of people who apply the knowledge in a problematic of great social relevance and public interest (Strategic Plan IPLeia, 2017).

PARTNERS/RESEARCH TEAM

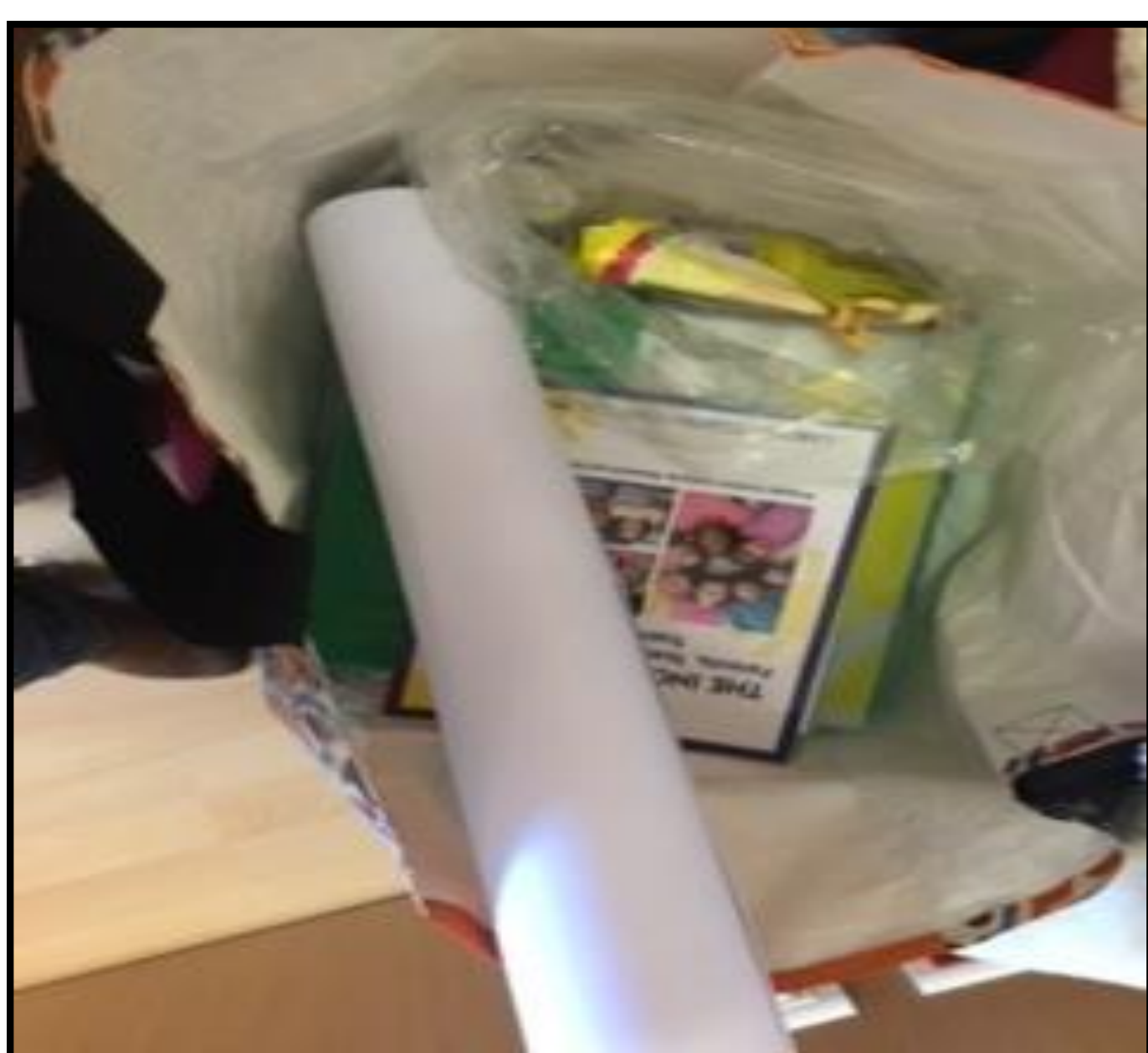
The team will be formed by up to 16 elements, trained and supervised in the methodology *Teacher's Class Management*. They are ESSlei teachers, elements from Porto de Mós Autarchy, Leiria Autarchy and Private Social Solidarity Institutions from coverage area.

The team, in the community of origin, and with the educational agents will disseminate for free the methodology, in the theoretical-practical model so that they can then apply daily with children they work with, always between 3 and 8 years of age.

We will invest and qualifying the teacher's, those that everyday strengthens is classroom.

POTENTIAL RESULTS

It intends to invest in the skills of children and young people in the municipality of Leiria and Porto de Mós, Marinha Grande in the adults of tomorrow, being (or not) students of higher education. To this end, a free training network is created in the *Incredible Years* program Teachers Classroom Management, which will form formal caregivers who, in the context of their lives, interact with children from 3 to 8 years of age: nursery, teachers, technical and operational assistants (Gaspar, 2018).

By now, between October 2018 and June 2019 we have already formed 34 caregivers/educators. We expect to formed another group of 50 educators in 2020.

EXPECTED OUTPUTS

We intend to train in the *Teacher's ClassRoom Management* methodology of *Years Incredible* program, up to 135 educational agents and about 2000 children between the ages of 3 and 8 years old, during the project execution time, up to 2 to 3 years.



DISSEMINATION

The results of the project will be compiled and published. The project team will have the knowledge in the reference methodology of *Teachers ClassRoom Management* that can be replicated annually. Those who received the training may replicate in the groups they may have in subsequent years, at ages 3 to 8 years of age.



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
